









#### **EXISTING CONDITIONS**

- Asphalt dominates
- Poorly defined spaces = conflicts
- Water drainage issues
- Poor neighborhood connection
- Few natural areas (unusable!)
- Limited covered area
- Limited support for diverse play
  - Imaginative play
  - Creative constructive Play
  - Dramatic social Play
  - Climbing and jumping
  - Nature play exploration








#### **PLAY IN NATURE**

Some contact with nature during the school day has been shown to improve children's concentration and self-discipline in the classroom

(Wells 2000, Grahn, et al. 1997, Taylor 2002)

Natural play environments stimulate social interaction between children and reduce the incidence of bullying. (Moore 1986, Bixler et al. 2002,

Malone & Tranter 2003)
